We sent a check for \$3,200 for reservations for four delegates. Two from Admiral Farragut and two from Osceola High School. Bill England sponsored a red/white shirt for \$500 for the June event.

Special Events –

The 25th annual Treasure Bay Tennis & Golf Classis was held on Feb 23 & 24th; this is major fund-raising event for GB Rotary Foundation annual grants; through sponsorships and a silent auction. We also host a tennis and golf event with the City of Treasure Island on the Saturday morning, as well as host the Women's Tennis Team of St Peter College on the Friday night at the main Dinner.

Upcoming in March –

Our weekly Happy Dollars will be CART donations from the Club to Rotary International.

We will have four meetings, with the March 5th meeting a Club Assembly.

March 14-16th is our second major fund raiser this year, featuring a carnival, battle of the bands, vendors, food, etc. in Maderia Beach. Thousands attend the event, and proceeds are spilt ½ with the City of Maderia Beach.

We will host an annual community Easter egg hunt on March 30th, with our interact club from Admiral Farragut's assistance (setup and the Easter bunny costume). We expect at a minimum one hundred children for the event at the Treasure Island Community Center and Park.
